## CONFIRMATION & YOUTH GROUP

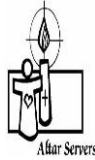
Registration for Confirmation will be on **Thursday October 6<sup>th</sup>** at 7 p.m.– 8:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall.
