Liturgy Corner

Sunday Mass Without Music???

It's difficult to imagine a Sunday liturgy without music. Indeed the church states that music is integral to the celebration, not an add-on! (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy # 112) Although prior to Vatican II, a choir often did most of the singing, today everyone is meant to sing the following: hymns (Gathering, Offertory and Communion processional), Gloria, sometimes the Kyrie, responsorial psalm, gospel acclamation, and Eucharistic prayer acclamations which often include the preface dialogue. The cantor, choir and instrumentalists enable this sung prayer of the assembly; unlike a secular concert they are not entertainers who invite us to listen. The psalmist told us to 'sing with joy unto the Lord.' There is a long history, back to the Basilians, of liturgical music being a priority at St. Basil's. Let us continue to sing God's praises with full voice.
